Lois and Henry Wiggan, Eva and Isla Siegal, Eddie Gibbons, and Emma Merrick were very welcome additions to the squad and helped us enter a full team meaning we could compete in every event. ## Regional Competition - April / May 2023

Nine of Northgate's strongest swimmers took part in 2 excellent weekends of racing at the recent West Midland Championship, held at The Alan Higgs Centre in Coventry. The squad had some excellent performances including:

- 24 out of 26 races producing individual personal bests.
- Northgate swimmers competed in eight separate finals.
- 4 new club records were set in backstroke by Martha Gibbard for the age 12 50M & 100M backstroke and Emily Gurr broke the 50M & 100M backstroke for age 11.
- Martha Gibbard also won the gold medal for the 50M backstroke race and Emily Gurr claimed silver in the 1500M freestyle for good measure.
- Northgate also entered their first ever relay team in this championship, with Isaac Gibbard, Reagan Haden, Elliott Pabla and Alfie Berry all recording split times that if they had been individual races, would have smashed their personal bests!

A number of our swimmers have been achieving great things outside the club. We want to say a special congratulations to them all.
